During our Harvest Celebration in September, we had a special worship service of prayer for the whole family. We set up 7 prayer stations for everyone to go through then we returned to the main auditorium for a final sermon and refreshments.

In October, we launched a new youth ministry (pictured above) called "School Without Walls." Students are invited from our church and community to study specific biblical concepts. The topic of this last session was "Wisdom, An Operating System for Life," and we had 19 students attend.

We're preparing for Christmas and putting together a special holiday program for kids in area orphanages. We also plan to visit children in the hospital with this program and share with them about Christmas.



Last week my wife and I were able to take some time off and travel. We visited three different cities over three days: Warsaw, Dresden, and Prague.

Our son Ilya was invited to try out for a soccer club in Leipzig, Germany. Currently he's working on the papers for his visa. We appreciate you joining with us in praying for him.
